1. Complete Part 1 of this form.
2. This form is not an interstate entry permit. However, if stock are likely to be sold or moved onwards from a show, Part 2 must be completed by your local animal health official to assist authorities prepare the necessary official interstate movement certificates.
3. If Johne's disease (JD) testing has been undertaken, have your approved veterinarian complete Part 3, or attach a signed veterinary certificate.
4. This Herd Health Status Declaration form is valid for 6 months from the date of issue. The owner must notify the issuing government veterinarian or Animal Health Officer of any change in herd status or other information provided on the form subsequent to completion of this form.
